




Brand Family Fares

A fare family, in travel, refers to a grouping of airline fares that offer similar benefits and restrictions. Airlines often categorize their fares into different families or classes, each with its own set of rules, amenities, and pricing. These fare families can vary from airline to airline.

To get the Fare Brand names and tier levels use :FX in fare display

Eg: FDCMBAUH20AUG/EY:FX



To get the fares with baggage allowance you can use the fare quote as per the tier levels given on the right side of the fare display in front of the Brand Name

- Same baggage allowance for whole itinerary: **FQCEY*:BF08**
- Segment specified baggage allowance with different tier levels: FQS1*:BF1.2*:BF3/CMH

Fare families can be accomplished in 3 ways.

1. On Availability

By clicking on "B" indicator on Availability.
