



## Re-Order Segments (replace) in a Booking file

Have you come across an instance where the booked segments on a PNR were not in date order?

Eg ;

How do to reorder the segments in date order?

- Identify the segment which should be replaced. Eg. Segment **3**
- Identify after (/) which segment the identified segment should be replaced.

Eg segment **0**

Enter: **/0S3** to move actual segment 3 after segment 0

| Explanation                            | Format |
|--|--------|
| Move segment 6 to follow segment 3     | /3S6   |
| Move segment 3 - 5 to follow segment 2 | /2S3-5 |
