What sell indicators may be returned by an airline?

There are “three” sell indicators that may be returned.

Indicator :	Explanation:
O (O*)	<p>Option sell or secured sell. The airline will send a vendor locator to the Galileo Booking File when the transaction has been ended; and the requested number of seats will be reduced from the airline's inventory .</p> <p>Note: An asterisk indicates that a vendor locator has been received from the airline</p>
S (S*)	<p>Super guaranteed sell. The airline will send a vendor locator to the Galileo Booking File when the transaction has been ended; and the requested number of seats will be reduced from the airline's inventory at time of the end transact.</p> <p>Note: An asterisk indicates that a vendor locator has been received from the airline.</p>
G	<p>Guaranteed sell. No vendor locator will be sent to the Booking File.</p>

* Any flight sold **without** an **O*/S*/G** guarantee may be rejected **within 12 hours** of the reservation being made.

* However **O*** will **NOT** return when the airline generates the segments/schedule changes/waitlist segments getting confirmed with the status code of **TK/KL/KK**.
